Dear Sir / Madam,

West Bengal State Council of Technical Education has made arrangements for counseling of the students for admission to the polytechnics of the State of West Bengal through different modes of admission. The said counseling for the academic session 2010-11 is being conducted through online procedure. The Council has taken all possible steps to fill-up all the seats of all the polytechnics. But even after completion of 3<sup>rd</sup> phase counseling for JEXPO and POLY-40, it has been observed that there are still few vacant seats in some specified branch in the private polytechnics. It has, therefore, been decided that another allotment will be made in 4<sup>th</sup> phase to fill-up those vacant seats in private polytechnics by allotting 30% extra students over and above the vacancy position after completion of 3<sup>rd</sup> phase counseling. The said allotment for JEXPO has already been given on 4<sup>th</sup> August, 2010 and in the administrative panel the list of such students has been provided with their mobile number so that the concerned institutes can also take-up the matter at their end. Such candidates have been advised to take admission within 10<sup>th</sup> August, 2010. Similar allotment in case of POLY-40 will also be made and the concerned candidates will be advised to take admission within 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2010.

You are, therefore, requested to admit the students who have been allotted seats during 4<sup>th</sup> phase through JEXPO and POLY-40 even if the total number of students admitted goes beyond the limit of approved intake capacity to be provided by the Council to a private institution.

In this connection it may also be mentioned that the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education will not allot any student after 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2010. The vacant seats, if any, may be filled up from the merit listed candidates of JEXPO and on the basis of marks in strict compliance with the norms of admission of the Council. Those students should also be charged in the manner as laid down in the Government Order bearing no. 582-TET(Poly)/11C-8/2009 dated 29.07.2009 for the students admitted through central counseling.
