

Admission of students in Polytechnics on the basis of marks obtained in Madhyamik or its equivalent examinations in the academic session 2008-2009 (except Darjeeling Polytechnic, Kurseong and Siliguri Government Polytechnic)

Applications are invited in prescribed form from the candidates who have passed Madhyamik or its equivalent examinations obtaining a minimum aggregate of 60% marks in Mathematics and Physical Science taken together for direct admission to 40% seats of the listed Polytechnics of the State. The norms of selection of candidates for such admission will be on the basis of merit ranking based on the results of the qualifying examination. The facility of direct admission will be available to the students who have passed the Madhyamik or its equivalent examination from schools of the district in which the candidate is a resident and seeking admission to the polytechnics under the same district with the following exceptions:

- a) Candidates belonging to Kolkata, 24 Parganas (North & South), Howrah and Hooghly districts will be eligible for admission to any polytechnic falling within the aforesaid districts. For filling up of choice of district in the application form, these districts will be known as '**Kolkata**' district.
- b) Candidates of both the districts of Uttar & Dakshin Dinajpur will be eligible for admission to Raiganj Polytechnic, Uttar Dinajpur. For filling up of choice of district in the application form, these districts will be known as '**Dinajpur**' district.

The students who have passed Madhyamik or its equivalent examination from schools of the district in which the candidate is a resident and seeking admission to the polytechnics under the same district, they have to apply *in 'Orange' coloured application form*.

Candidates seeking admission to a course, which is not available in the polytechnic(s) of the concerned district may also apply for that course only in other polytechnic (*in 'Pink' coloured application forms*) stating the branch in which admission is sought.

A candidate should submit single 'Orange' coloured application form for admission to the polytechnics of a particular district. He/She may also submit single 'Pink' coloured application form in case of seeking admission to a course, which is not available in the polytechnic(s) of the district in which the candidate is a resident.

In case, a female candidate has changed her place of residence due to marriage, she will be allowed to apply to a polytechnic of the changed district. Similarly, if a candidate has studied in a boarding school, he/she will be allowed to take admission in the district of his/her permanent residence. Change of district will also be allowed when father/guardian is transferred to the concerned district. ***Authentic document will have to be produced at the time of counselling in all the above cases.***

Reservations of seats are available for SC/ST/Physically Challenged/ITI passed candidates as per Government rules. No seats are reserved for 'OBC' category candidates. SC/ST candidates will be required to obtain caste certificate from competent authorities in West Bengal before submission of application.

Seats will be filled up on the basis of district quota as follows:

- i) For ITI students – 10% of seats will be reserved for the holders of National Trade Certificates (NCVT) in various Engineering Trades. They must have obtained minimum 60% marks in Mathematics and Physical Science taken together in Madhyamik or equivalent examination. They will be considered for admission in such branches which are identical to the trade in which they have passed e.g. (a) Fitter, Turner, Machinist, etc. will be considered for Mechanical Engineering,

(b) Electrician, Wireman, etc. will be considered for Electrical Engineering, (c) Draughtsman (Civil), Surveyor, etc. will be considered for Civil Engineering and like others. Said 10% seats will be subject to usual reservation of seats for SC, ST and female candidates. If sufficient candidates are not available those may be filled-up by the general candidates.

- ii) Out of the balance seats, 50% will be filled up by the male candidates and remaining 50% will be earmarked for the female candidates subject to availability of female candidates. If any reserved seats meant for female candidates remain unfilled in any polytechnic of any district that seat will be filled up by male candidate of that district.

Prescribed application forms will be available on and from 02.05.2008 to 23.05.2008 from 11.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. on payment of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred) only in cash from the polytechnics, listed below. Upper age limit of the applicants is 21 years as on 1st January 2008, relaxable by 3 (three) years for SC & ST candidates. Upper age limit for the candidates other than SC/ST is relaxable by 1 (one) year, if the merit positions are in the zone of consideration.

Last date of submission of completed application is 23.05.2008 upto 4.00 p.m. However, in case of candidates who have appeared in Madhyamik or equivalent examination conducted by Boards which have Examination Centres in West Bengal in 2008 and if the result of the said examination is not published within 22.05.2008, the last date for submission of completed application is within 10 (ten) days from the date of publication of the result of Madhyamik or equivalent examination but they have to collect the application form within the same period i.e. 02.05.2008 to 23.05.2008.
