

JOINT ENTRANCE EXAMINATION (JEXPO-2010) FOR ADMISSION TO POLYTECHNICS IN WEST BENGAL FOR ACADEMIC SESSION 2010 – 2011

Applications are invited from the candidates in prescribed form for admission to 1st year Diploma Courses in 54 Polytechnics in West Bengal for the academic session 2010-2011 through a Joint Entrance Examination (JEXPO-2010) to be conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education “Kolkata Karigori Bhavan”, 2nd Floor, 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata – 700 013. The examination with multiple choice objective questions on each paper is scheduled to be held on Sunday, the 2nd May, 2010 consisting of Mathematics (100 marks – 2 hours duration) and Physics & Chemistry (100 marks – 2 hours duration). A merit list will be prepared on the basis of the result of the Joint Entrance Examination. The Institute where students can be admitted and other general information are available in the Instruction Booklet, which will be provided with the application form.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant(s) must be Indian citizen and should have passed Madhyamik Examination from West Bengal Board of Secondary Education or its equivalent Board/Council. Candidates due to appear in the Madhyamik or its equivalent examination in 2010 with Mathematics, Physical Science & English may also apply. An applicant must not have been born before 01.01.1989 (for SC/ST students 01.01.1986). Relaxation of 1 year for general candidates only on special ground may also be allowed. Willing candidates may also see notification for admission in the website of the West Bengal State Council of Technical Education at www.webscte.org.

RESERVATION

Reservation of seats as per existing Government norms. SC/ST candidates of the State of West Bengal will only get the benefit of reservation. SC/ST/PC certificates issued after 11th February, 2010 and by the competent authority other than that of Government of West Bengal will not be entertained for admission in the session 2010-11.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

Candidates willing to appear in the Joint entrance Examination (JEXPO-2010) should fill-in application in prescribed form which shall be made available together with the Instruction Booklet on and from 01.01.2010 to 30.01.2010 from the following Polytechnics listed below on all working days between 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. and on Saturday between 10.30 a.m. and 1.00 p.m. (Sunday and holidays excluded) on cash payment of Rs. 300/-. Application form once purchased cannot be taken back or exchanged.

Application form duly filled-in, is to be submitted to the receiving centres (as mentioned in the Instruction booklet) on any working day [except Saturdays/Sundays and gazetted holidays] between 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. up to 30.01.2010. Candidate(s) intending to obtain the application form(s) and instruction booklet(s) by post should apply in writing addressed to the “Secretary, West Bengal State Council of Technical Education “Kolkata Karigori Bhavan”, 2nd Floor, 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata – 700 013, enclosing therewith a Demand Draft of Rs. 300/- drawn in Favour of “West Bengal State Council of Technical Education” payable at Kolkata along with a self-addressed stamped envelope (25cm x 13cm) affixing thereon a postage stamp worth Rs.55/- for receiving the application form by speed Post. The request for Application Form should reach the said office on or before 15.01.2010. Application Forms, duly filled-in, may be sent by post to the Council’s office at above address so as to reach by 03.02.2010. Council will not be responsible for any postal delay. Forms may also be purchased after the due date of 30.01.2010, on payment of Rs.400/- (Rs. 300/- towards cost of form plus Rs. 100/- as late fee) from the office of the Council at “Kolkata Karigori Bhavan”, 2nd Floor, 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata – 700 013, on all working days from 10.30 a.m. to 4.00 p.m. between 02.02.2010 and 09.02.2010 and may be submitted at the Council’s Office at “Kolkata Karigori Bhavan”, 110 S.N.Banerjee Road, Kolkata-700013 on all working days between 10.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. on or before 11.02.2010.

Admission of prospective applicants to Polytechnics is subject to fulfilment of eligibility criteria by them. The result of this competitive examination based on multiple choice type objective questions (MCQ) – JEXPO-2010 will not be intimated individually to the merit listed candidates. The Council shall publish a merit list on the basis of the results of the JEXPO-2010 which will be available in the website www.webscte.org tentatively during the last week of May, 2010. No Rank Card will be issued by the council to the merit listed candidates. They are required to follow the council’s website at www.webscte.org for obtaining information regarding online counselling programme. No request for post publication scrutiny, inspection and review shall be entertained. Mere submission of application for appearing in the Joint Entrance Examination (JEXPO-2010) and/or securing a rank in the merit list does not entitle a prospective candidate for admission to any Polytechnic.
