

ADMISSION TO PART-TIME EVENING DIPLOMA COURSE IN ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY
FOR THE BONA FIDE EMPLOYED PERSONS (SESSION 2008-09)

Applications are invited in prescribed form from the employed persons who are citizen of India and domicile of West Bengal at least for the last two years from the date of application for admission to 1st year of the Part-time Diploma Courses in the following polytechnics – (i) Asansol Polytechnic (ME, EE), (ii) Hooghly Institute of Technology (ME, EE, CE), (iii) North Calcutta Polytechnic (ME, EE, CE), (iv) Central Calcutta Polytechnic (ME, EE, ETCE), (v) Harashankar Bhattacharya Institute of Technology & Mining (MIN), (vi) Regional Institute of Printing Technology (DP) on payment of Rs.200/- (Rupees two hundred only) in cash from the said polytechnics. Candidates may apply for admission to more than one polytechnic of their choice by submitting separate application for each polytechnic. Application forms will be available and received by the abovementioned polytechnics from 07.05.2008 to 28.05.2008 between 11.00 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. from Monday to Friday and between 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. on Saturday. The last date of receiving of filled-in application form is 30.05.2008 up to 4.00 p.m.

1. **Mode of Selection**

There will be a Common Entrance Test to be held on Sunday, 22.06.2008 from 11.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m. Questions will be of MCQ type consisting of Mathematics (50 marks), Physics (15 marks), Chemistry (15 marks) and basic questions from Civil Engineering (CE) / Printing Technology (DP) / Electrical Engineering (EE) / Mining Engineering (MIN) (20 marks). Time allowed 2 hours. The question for Common Entrance Test will consist of four modules: 1st – Mathematics, 2nd – Physics, 3rd – Chemistry and 4th – Basic Engineering (Civil / Electrical / Mechanical / Electronics & Telecommunication / Mining / Printing). Module 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be compulsory. 4th module of Engineering will be required to be attempted by the candidate on the appropriate branch of engineering for which he is seeking admission. Candidates appearing at the Common Entrance Test are required to collect Admit Cards on 18th & 19th June, 2008 between 11.00 a.m. to 1.30 p.m. from the respective institute, where the application form have been submitted.

2. **Eligibility criteria for all branches other than Mining Engineering**

- i) Pass in Madhyamik or its equivalent examination with Mathematics and Physical Science with 3 (three) years working experience in the related trade in which admission is sought;
OR
- ii) Pass in Madhyamik or its equivalent examination with Mathematics and Physical Science and holding National Trade Certificate (NTC) with one year working experience in the related trade in which admission is sought;
OR
- iii) Pass in Madhyamik or its equivalent examination with Mathematics and Physical Science and holding National Apprenticeship Certificate (NAC) with one year working experience in the related trade in which admission is sought;
OR
- iv) Pass in (10+2) in Science Stream having Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics subjects with one year working experience in the related field in which admission is sought;
OR
- v) Pass in (10+2) in Vocational Stream with one year working experience in the related field in which admission is sought.

[In all the above cases, working experience should be post qualification and the same will be counted as on 01.01.2008]

3. **Eligibility criteria for the branch of Mining Engineering for admission to Harashankar Bhattacharya Institute of Technology & Mining, Raniganj**

- i) The sponsored candidates from M/s. Eastern Coalfield Limited (ECL) should have passed Madhyamik / Secondary / equivalent examination with Physical Science and Mathematics and must possess at least 3 years' working experience in Mining related jobs. Application from the following categories of employees working in any mine of ECL would not be considered:–
- a) Overman;
 - b) Surface Worker;
 - c) Surveyors or persons working in Survey Department; and
 - d) Piece rated worker.
- ii) The sponsored candidates from other Mining organisations except M/s. Eastern Coalfield Limited should possess:–
- a) Pass in Madhyamik / Secondary / equivalent examinations holding National Trade Certificate (NTC) with one year working experience in the related field;
OR
 - b) Pass in Higher Secondary examination with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and must possess one year working experience in the related Mining field;
OR
 - c) Pass in Madhyamik / Secondary / equivalent examination with Physical Science and Mathematics and three years' working experience in the related Mining field.

4. **Age**

Not below 19 years as on 01.01.2008. There is no upper age limit.

5. **Reservation**

Reservation of seats for SC, ST, PC and other category of candidates will be as per existing Government norms.
